

# 2019 INDIANA LIGHTING PROGRAM FAQs

## **Q: When we will receive a new application form and measure list?**

A: If you did not receive the updated application form and measure lists, those can be downloaded from the website [ElectricIdeas.com/Work](http://ElectricIdeas.com/Work).

## **Q: Is there a need to resubmit projects that have already been submitted?**

A: There is no need to resubmit projects that have already been submitted. We will review and ensure these have not started prior to moving forward with the projects.

## **Q: How have the incentives been affected?**

A: With the 50% incremental cost protocol, most of the incentives are around 50% of what they were at the beginning of the year.

## **Q: I have a project that has already been approved, will the offered amount be honored?**

A: If a project has already received an incentive offer, it will be honored at the rate in which it was offered. No changes to existing projects already approved.

## **Q: Will the program last through the remainder of 2019?**

A: Based upon our analysis, the current funding should allow the programs to remain open throughout 2019 and with timely IURC approval, a smooth transition into 2020.

## **Q: Are CFL to LED and Incandescent to LED measures now Custom?**

A: Yes, CFL and Incandescent to LED measures are now Custom and require pre-approval.

## **Q: What is the process of approval for Prescriptive projects recently completed before new rules were put into place and not yet submitted?**

A: We will evaluate these on a case-by-case basis. We encourage you to submit your project with a justification as to why you should receive an exception to the rule.

## **Q: Can you give an example of base line vs. equipment cost?**

A: Baseline would be the replacement with the exact equipment that is currently installed at the facility. Material equipment cost would be the cost of the new energy efficient equipment.

## **Q: What will the incentives and requirements for the 2020 program look like?**

A: We anticipate the incentives and new requirements will be similar to the revisions made effective June 3, 2019.
